Curriculum

It is no secret that Year 6 is the time to take your SATs. These assessments are nothing to be worried about, they are a great opportunity for you to show off all of the knowledge you have gained in your time at Hillary. *We will prepare you for SAT's and tell you everything that you need to know when you return to school - they are not as scary as you may think!*



In Year 6, we focus a lot on maths and English to be as prepared as we can for SAT's but we do lots of other interesting subjects too! Here is some information about the subjects we will do in Year 6:

Maths

In Year 6 we revise lots of the maths you will already know - any aspects of maths that you are still not confident with we will go over again. We also cover ratio, area of circles and algebra, which you may not have done before.

English

We start every English lesson with a SPAG starter to help you become better at spelling and grammar. We read some wonderful books in Year 6 and we work hard to produce some excellent pieces of writing. You will also create your own book with Boomwriter!

Reading

We have comprehension lessons in Year 6; some of these take part in the afternoon. We like to set skim and scan challenges to see how many words you can find in a set amount of time.

Other subjects

You will still have science, history, geography and PE lessons. Some topics we cover in Y6 are: North America, Evolution, World War 1, the Victorians and Early Islamic Civilisation. We will do lots of art and DT work during the summer term. We also have weekly Thrive time.

Homework

You will be given homework weekly. It will be given every Friday and due back in the following Tuesday. It will be a mixture of maths, grammar and reading. Homework needs to be completed on time. We will go through it together in class to discuss any aspects you may have found difficult.


If we respect each other, help each other and treat each other with kindness then we will make a great team! We will work hard in Year 6 but we will also have lots of exciting opportunities and experiences.
