Water bottles




Water bottles will be kept at the sink in class. They need to be taken home everyday so that they can be washed and refilled. Please do not bring fizzy drinks into school

***Respect** – we will show respect to everyone and everything around us. We will listen to each other and value other opinions and views*


***Reciprocity** – we will work hard as a team and help each other*

***Resourcefulness** – we will all contribute to school life and share ideas*


***Resilience** – we will always try our best but most of all we will never give up!*

We can not wait to start our new year 3 journey...can you?




